



## **2011 LibraryCo Inc. CALL/ACBD New Law Librarians' Institute 2011 Bursary**

### **Purpose of the Bursary**

LibraryCo is offering two bursaries to support eligible county and district law library staff to attend the New Law Librarians' Institute 2011. This Institute is being presented by the Canadian Association of Law Libraries/Association canadienne des bibliothèques de droit at the University of Western Ontario in London, Ontario from June 5-10, 2011. This is the first time that the Institute has been offered by CALL/ACBD.

The New Law Librarians' Institute, sponsored by CALL/ACBD, is an intensive, week-long program aimed at developing librarians' skills in the key competencies of law librarianship. The program will feature expert instruction from leading law librarians and law professors, small class size, a mix of lectures and practical sessions, hands on sessions and valuable take-home materials. The Institute will be held at the University of Western Ontario with accommodation in the university's residences. The target audience is:

- persons interested in pursuing a career in law librarianship
- recent graduates of library education programs
- mid-career librarians from other fields who are interested in starting anew in law libraries

The registration fee is \$1,495 plus \$194.35 HST for a total of \$1,689.35. It includes Institute sessions and supplemental materials, accommodations at the University of Western Ontario residences from Sunday June 5 to Thursday June 9, breakfast and lunch from Monday June 6 to Friday June 10 and the Opening Reception on Sunday, June 5. It does not include other meals, incidental expenses or travel to and from London.

The LibraryCo Board of Directors will support up to two qualified individuals up to an amount of \$1,700 each to cover the registration fee for the Institute. Attendees and/or their associations will be responsible for other costs.

### **Guidelines Governing the Bursary**

All Ontario county and district law library staff who meet the following criteria are eligible to apply:

- they must be in their first three years of work in a law library
- they must be able to attend the conference in its entirety (Sunday evening through Friday)

### **Recipients' Obligations**

Recipients are expected to provide LibraryCo with a written report on or before June 30, 2011 with a summary of their participation in the Institute and how they gained from the experience.
