



Integration Licensing Process offers unique opportunity
The Law Society is offering collection agents and members of some of the groups previously exempt from paralegal licensing an opportunity to apply for a paralegal licence. Applicants will have 12 months to apply for the Integration Licensing Process - from October 1, 2010 to September 30, 2011 - and must complete all the requirements of the process by May 31, 2014.

Law Society Annual Reports go "Paperless" in 2010

Beginning this year, all communication relating to annual filing will be sent electronically by email, along with a year-end email containing a link to access the e-filing site.

The Law Society of Upper Canada was saddened to learn of the death of Laura Legge, O. Ont., Q.C., on October 5, 2010. Although Mrs. Legge's contributions to the Law Society and the profession are innumerable, she is best known as the first woman elected bencher and Treasurer of the Law Society. Mrs. Legge became the first woman elected as a bencher of the Law Society in 1975. She made history again in 1983 when her fellow benchers elected her Treasurer. Mrs. Legge was re-elected as Treasurer in 1984 and 1988 and continued to actively serve as ex-officio bencher.

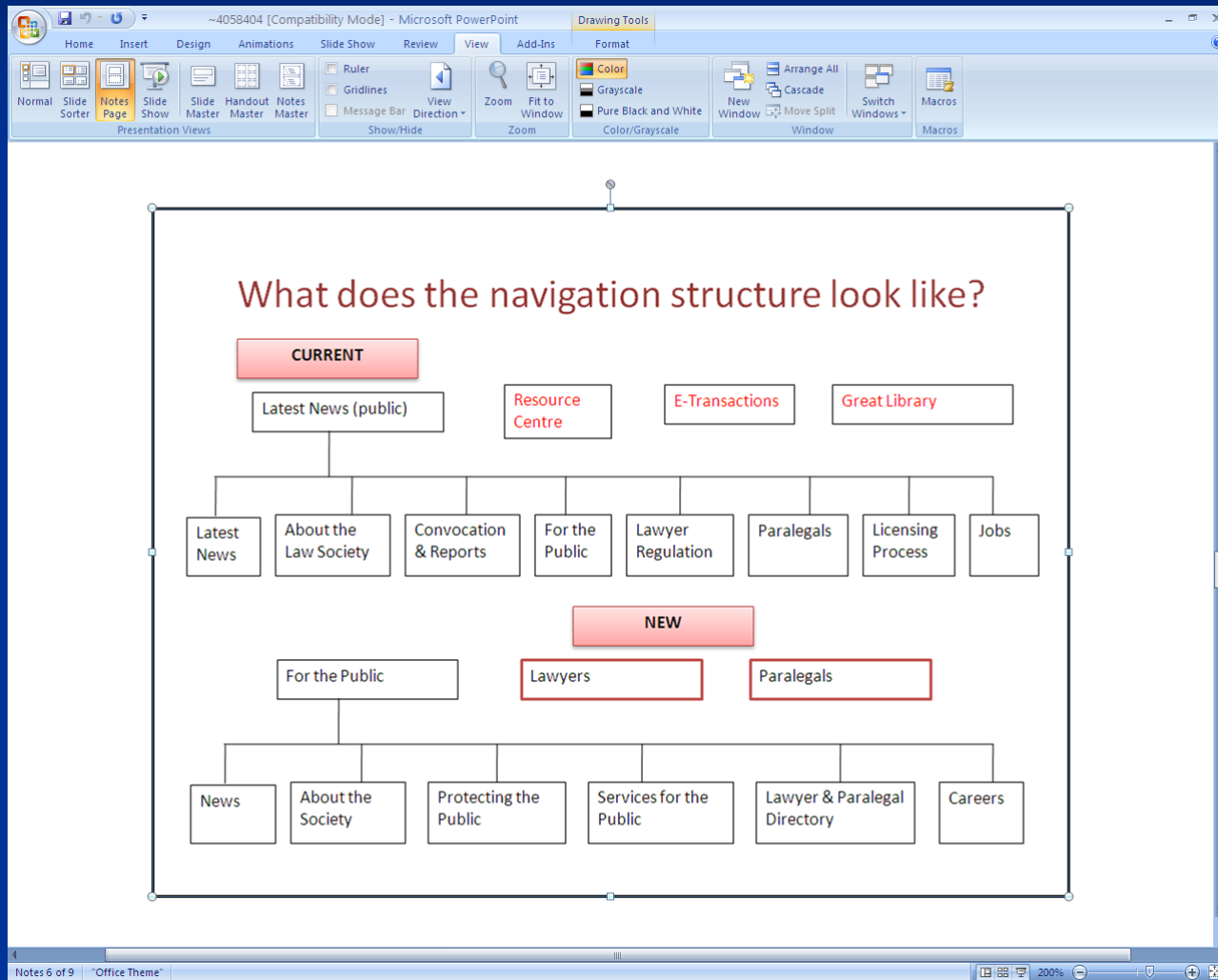
