



Guidelines for Retention of Annotated Statutes in County and District Law Libraries

The following guidelines have been endorsed by the LibraryCo *Collections Team* and the LibraryCo Board of Directors. They are recommended for use at local law libraries. Area and regional law libraries may find them to be useful as a guide as well.

Bound volumes of *Annotated Statutes* have become very popular in the past several years. Depending on volume and nature of use in the law library retain only two or three years.

There may be exceptions to this (e.g. Annotated Criminal Code – Martins or Tremear's) but larger law libraries in the system will retain historic collections of annotated acts
